Mrs Hallam will be teaching the Year 2 children from Monday morning until Thursday lunchtime and Mrs Poppleton will be teaching on Thursday afternoon and all day Friday. We are also very lucky to have Miss Wiltshire, Miss Smith and Mrs Parr working with us this year.

Our topic for the Autumn Term is 'Me and My Family Tree'. During the first week, we will be talking about what we have done during the summer holiday.

In September, lots of the routines will be very similar to those in Year 1. However, there will also be some changes too.

### **Year 2 Routines**

In the morning, the children should line up outside the Year 2 classroom at 8.50am, ready to come into the classroom by themselves. The children line up in two lines: boys and girls.

Children should have these things at school every day.

- *waterproof coat*
- *PE kit*
- *water bottle*

Some of these items will obviously be given out during the first few weeks.

PE usually takes place on Mondays (and then Tuesdays when swimming stops). However, we ask that PE bags stay at school. PE kits will be sent home at the end of every half term to be washed.

Please ensure ALL clothing is clearly named, but especially school jumpers.

Children should drink water during the day. Squash is not allowed. Children can bring in their own water bottles. Please choose bottles with a sports lid to prevent excessive spillage.

We welcome help from parents, grandparents and carers in the classroom. If you would like to help with reading, changing books, learning times tables, creative activities, etc, please let us know. Any help would be hugely appreciated, even if it is not on a regular basis.
