Date	Big items	Small items
2 <sup>nd</sup> Oct	Suitcases, briefcases	Kitchen pots and pans, baking trays, wooden spoons, chopping boards
9 <sup>th</sup> Oct	Pushchairs (child sized not doll sized), plastic milk/bread crates and anything on castors/wheels	Small spades, shovels, trowels and brooms
16 <sup>th</sup> Oct	Road signs and cones	Buckets, nets and thick rope
7 <sup>th</sup> Nov	Bodyboards and pool noodles	Fabric – large sheets, brightly coloured fabric
14 <sup>th</sup> Nov	Wooden pallets	Hats, scarves, jazzy shirts, waistcoats
21 <sup>st</sup> Nov	Metal frames	Pegs for den building
28 <sup>th</sup> Nov	Cable drums	Plastic toolboxes
5 <sup>th</sup> Dec	Guttering	Keyboards, torches, laptops, desk phones, that are no longer working
